CONSTITUTION

Article 1: Name.

The name of the organization shall be the Manitoba Orienteering Association, (herein known as M.O.A. or the Association).

Article 2: Authorization:

- a) The M.O.A. is a non-profit organization.
- b) The Association is recognized by the Canadian Orienteering Federation as the authorized governing body of orienteering in Manitoba.
- c) The Association recognizes the Canadian Orienteering Federation as the Canadian governing body of orienteering, and shall abide by the Rules and Regulations of the C.O.A. except where prevented by local condition, laws and customs.

Article 3: Objectives:

- a) To promote and support Orienteering in Manitoba.
- b) To establish and standardize the rules governing Orienteering competition, and the classification of competitors.
- c) To hold annually a Provincial Orienteering Championship Competition at such a place as may be selected by the Association.
- d) To arrange for the selection of competitors and delegates to represent Manitoba in the National Orienteering Championships and in the National Orienteering Conferences.
- e) To maintain a bureau of information regarding Orienteering activities in Manitoba.
- f) To provide, upon request, for the arbitration of such differences as may arise between groups or persons holding membership in the Federation.
- g) To approve- all official Provincial Orienteering events in Manitoba
- h) To provide incentive for performance and commendable achievement in Orienteering, and other appropriate associated activities.
- i) To render all possible services, assistance and other support for the development and extension of Orienteering.
